Oral presentations

Poster presentations

The posters should include an introduction, objectives, materials and methods, results, discussion, conclusions and references.

Maximum poster size is 100 cm height by 70 cm

Authors are expected to be beside their posters during their assigned poster session reception. The poster area will always be accessible during the conference time.
